

## Canadian Anglican Cursillo

### WEBSITE

The Canadian Anglican Cursillo Secretariat has created a website for the purposes of sharing information with all Diocesan Cursillo Movements across the Anglican Church of Canada. It has also been created as a site where individual Cursillistas and anyone interested in finding out about the Anglican expression of Cursillo in Canada can visit and explore what is available.

To that end:

1. The domain name for the website shall be [www.anglicancursillo.com](http://www.anglicancursillo.com)
2. The design and maintenance of the website is the responsibility of the website manager, who is appointed by the CACS Chairperson at the beginning of his/her three year term and makes changes at the request of the Chair.
3. A web-hosting service shall be selected with consideration for services available, customer service, accessibility, as well as cost. A Canadian host is preferred.
4. The hosting service package should include a sufficient amount of disk storage space and traffic quota (band-width) and offer additional services such as individual email addresses for CACS members, file management, website usage statistics, etc.
5. The CACS Treasurer shall ensure that the fees for domain name registration and web hosting service are paid.
6. Website content should include, but not necessarily be limited to:
  - History of CACS
  - CACS contacts
  - Frequently Asked Questions about Cursillo
  - Links to other relevant websites:
    - National Episcopal Cursillo, USA
    - Roman Catholic Cursillo, USA
    - Presbyterian Cursillo in Canada
    - Canadian Conference of Catholic Cursillos (CCCC)
    - Anglican Diocesan Cursillo Movements in Canada
    - Anglican Church of Canada
  - Information on Anglican Diocesan Cursillo Movement events, prayer requests and dates of upcoming weekends]

7. Personal information will not be shared on the website. This includes addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses.
  8. Email addresses included for purposes of usability shall be encoded for protection from spam robots and other risks to personal privacy.
  9. Any photographs used on the website, other than that of CACS members, must have the prior written approval of all those included in the photograph before it is placed on the website.
  10. The website should be updated at least monthly. It is the responsibility of the CACS Chairperson to advise the website manager of all additions and updates to be placed on the website.
