A major focus of this meeting was to make the final plans for the CAC **Triennial Meeting** to be held in **Ottawa June 22-24, 2012**. five Cursillistas attended, with some members of the neighbouring Nova Scotia PEI Diocese participating, too. It was a joyous and Spirit-filled weekend, and CACS has now made the decision to offer CLW weekends prior to each CACS meeting, as we rotate meetings around the country.
